In this role, Ms. Foley oversees the coordination and administration of components of CIVOC programs which include and may be related to our expansive food pantry program, holistic therapies, financial planning, client transportation, work with incarcerated veterans, elder veteran outreach and employment workshops which we offer to our veteran clients and their families. Her responsibilities also include planning, organizing, staffing, leading, and controlling all program activities.
